Topics

Year 1 Topics this term

We are reading the book "The Naughty Bus" and will be retelling the story of the bus journey. For Maths we are learning about measure, weight, height, time and money. Within Science we are continuing to identify birds and plants in our local park and are going to make a bird feeder. We will also be looking at using different types of transport, and how transport has changed compared to the children's grandparents time.

Year 2 Topics this term

We are looking at what people were like in our town 100 years ago and what life was like. Within science we are learning about how chefs grow their ingredients to use in their recipes. During English lessons we are reading the classic novel "Oliver" by Charles Dickens. In Maths we are continuing our number work and looking at shape and measures.
