### Topics

#### Year 3 Topics this term

Year 3 will be finding out about the Mediterranean. In particular the children will look at foods and customs from countries, as well as why the weather is warmer. They will also plan, prepare and participate in a Mediterranean fiesta that parents are more than welcome to attend (more information will follow). In science the children will be finding out about plants and flowers and how plants reproduce. In RE the children will be visiting a Synagogue as part of the rolling Newham RE syllabus, ensure knowledge and insight into all main religions.

#### Year 4 Topics this term

Year 4 will be looking at which animals and plants thrive in our locality as part of our science learning. We will also examine how and why animals are adapted to their local environment and how they survive.

We will continue learning about the significance of the Thames River and how it sources our lives daily. As part of circle time, we will look at "What makes me the person that I am and why I am unique." The main focus in PE will be on Athletics and the children will also complete an intensive 2 week swimming course at the Olympic pool.
