Year 3

This term the children will become mini programmers in ICT. In Spanish, they will focus on simple conversations, singing songs and playing games to learn important phrases. As part of their topic, they will learn about the, "Early settlers in Britain" and what life was like for them. As part of the RE learning in year 3, the children will find out about the significance of light in religions and why it is used in most faiths as part of their celebration.

Year4
